EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST & BOOKING

Expressions of interest for all activities must be completed online through the Google Form below https://forms.gle/U2vhSvUXphVhhaFU9 which will open for bookings on Friday 20th December 2024. Bookings will be open until Friday3rd January 2025. Should you require a paper booking form, please contact our Reception on 01626 367335. Year 9 students will have priority choice as this is their last Activities Week. Once activities have been allocated, you will receive written confirmation and a payment plan (if applicable) for each activity.

PAYMENT

ACTIVITIES WILL NOT BE PAID FOR AT THE TIME OF ONLINE EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST. Once your activity has been confirmed in writing (as above), you will be required to pay online via your ParentPay account. All payments are non-refundable, unless the activity is cancelled by the college. Once your place has been secured, this cannot be changed, unless there are exceptional circumstances.

ATTENDANCE

We regard Activities Week as an important part of your child's development and, as a result, attendance is compulsory. Any unauthorised absence during this week could result in a Penalty Notice. Any absence should be notified in the usual manner through our absence lines, on 01626 367335, School Gateway or by emailing attendance@nacollege.devon.sch.uk

If your child is unable to attend due to sickness, we will be unable to refund any payments unless covered by an insurance policy where a residential activity has been booked. Absences of 4 days or more due to illness will require written medical evidence to be provided.

Any student who does not book activities during the booking period will automatically be enrolled on onsite supervision for the entire week. Students will be engaged in classroom-based activities and supervised by a member of staff at all times.

BEHAVIOUR

We have very high expectations regarding the conduct and behaviour of our students, both within the college and in the wider community. The majority of our students rise to these expectations and are a credit to both the college and their families. It is therefore vitally important that these standards are maintained, particularly on offsite visits where the reputation of the college needs to be upheld.

Whilst we do not anticipate any major concerns or issues to arise with students selected to participate on any offsite visits, it should be noted that we may reserve the right to remove students from a trip who we feel are unable to maintain the high standards of conduct we expect. In the unlikely event of this happening, the decision will be made by the Headteacher of the College. In these circumstances any monies paid will be refunded.

Do you love horses and wild animals? Do you get a thrill from riding across the open moor and want to find out more about looking after horses, donkeys and wild animals? Then this trip is for you!

Animal Antics week will involve spending a day riding across Dartmoor, visiting Longleat Safari Park, Dartmoor Zoo & finishing the week with a trip to The Donkey Sanctuary, where we can visit our adopted donkey – Drizzle!

The trip to Longleat will require an early start with students needing to be in College at 7.15am and will not return until 5.30pm. The rest of the days will be within the normal college day. You don't need any experience with horses to take part in the riding day.

The Hunger Games Cost: £190 Max No. 30 Years 7, 8 & 9 4 days (Mon - Thurs)

This trip is a unique opportunity to recreate a version of 'The Hunger Games' on Dartmoor, blending forest skills, nature awareness and storytelling. Tributes will spend the week immersed in the forest with two specific days at the Hunger Games 'Training Camp' where they learn survival skills such as fire making, shelter building, camouflage and sneaking/stalking. On the final day, Tributes are paired to enter the Arena and the games begin. Who will be this year's victor?
